Carol Iglesias Pastel Materials List

The following is a list of items that I like to use. These are only suggestions. You may use whatever materials that you have or prefer with the exception of a **toned sanded paper** (any color) which works best with my teaching techniques.

The items in bold are the most important supplies needed.

- $\sqrt{\,}$ Soft Pastels (I primarily use Sennelier Half sticks, Jack Richeson, Blue Earth or Great American.)
- √ Hard Pastels (I occasionally use a few Jack Richeson or Nupastel)
- √ Vine Charcoal or Graphite Stick
- √ **Small Sketchbook** (I use 3.5" x 5" Strathmore Sketch)
- $\sqrt{}$ Pastel Premier **Two 12" x 16" size sheets, toned** Pastel Premier **sanded paper.** It can be mounted or an individual sheet from an Assorted Colors Pack. (Various options available thru dakotapastels.com, Amazon, Dick Blick, or Jerry's Artarama.)
- $\sqrt{2}$ Painters tape for catching your pastel dust!
- √ Gloves in a Bottle/Barrier Cream and/or Gloves (I use VIPER x-small gloves)
- √ Baby Wipes and/or Paper Towels (Viva are best!)
- √ Black Ultra Fine Tip Pen (for sketching)
- $\sqrt{3}$ Values of Gray Markers (I like the No.1, 3 and 5 Cool Gray)
- $\sqrt{\mbox{1"}}$ White or Black Artists Tape or similar for mounting your paper
- $\sqrt{\text{Mounting Board}}$ (I like lightweight black plastic corrugated board or foamcore from Michaels)
- $\sqrt{\text{Photos}}$ your own to use as painting reference.
- $\sqrt{\mbox{Small Container with Corn Meal}}$ (to hold your working colors and to clean your pastels)
- $\sqrt{\text{Glassine Sheets (wax paper can also work to temporarily protect your work)}}$
