Paper:

Watercolor Block (At least 5 sheets)

*Glued on all 4 sides!

12" x 16" is a good size. I recommend Arches cold press watercolor block or individual sheets to ensure you have a good quality product.

Brushes:

1" Flat brush or larger

(Used for Larger Washes)

1/2" AND 1/4" Angle Brushes

(Used for Smaller Washes & Some Detail Work)

#2 Rigger Brush

(Used for Detail Work)

#4 Fan Brush

PAINT: (Tubes Only) I suggest to start with the **Primary Colors:**

Lemon Yellow

Cadmium Red

Alizarin Crimson

Rose Madder

Ultramarine Blue

Turquoise Blue

The Secondary Colors:

Hookers Green

Sap Green

Violet

Blue

& These Additional Colors:

Burnt Umber

Burnt Sienna

Payne's Gray
