Carol Iglesias Oil Materials List

The following is a list of items that I like to use. These are only suggestions. You may use whatever materials that you have or prefer.

The items in bold are the most important supplies needed.

√ **Oils** (I primarily use a limited palette of Titanium White, Cadmium Yellow Light, Yellow Ochre, Cadmium Red Light, Alizarin Crimson, Cerulean Blue, Ultramarine Blue, Sap Green or Veridian Green) Depending on the location, I sometimes add Cadmium Orange, Manganese Blue Hue or Cobalt Blue. I also use a Permalba White (very soft) and Transparent Red, Orange or Brown Oxide to tone my surface.

- √ **Small Sketchbook** (I use 3.5" x 5" Strathmore Sketch)
- $\sqrt{}$ (2) Oil Painting Panels or Canvas 11 x 14 or 12 x16 are good sizes. (I use Centurion OP DLX Linen Panels for plein air and stretched canvas for studio. Please **tone your panels or canvas** ahead of class with Transparent Red, Orange or Brown Oxide. Many options available thru Jerry's Artarama or Dick Blick)
- $\sqrt{\text{Brushes-}}$ Long Handle (I use **Filbert** or Egbert Brushes numbers **2**,4,**6**,**8**,10 and one old #2 bristle for drawing)
- $\sqrt{\text{Gloves}}$ in a Bottle/Barrier Cream and/or Gloves (I also use VIPER x-small gloves)
- $\sqrt{\text{Baby Wipes}}$ and/or **Paper Towels** (Viva or Shop Towels are best!)
- $\sqrt{}$ Black Ultra Fine Tip Pen (for sketching. I like uni ball gel pens)
- $\sqrt{3}$ Values of Gray Markers (I like the No.1, 3 and 5 Cool Gray)
- √ Gamblin Solvent Free Gel
- √ **Thinner** Gamsol (I use The Art Treehouse Biobased Artist Thinner, in a small container) <u>www.arttreehouse.com</u>
- $\sqrt{\text{Mixing Surface}}$ or disposable palettes.
- $\sqrt{\mbox{ Photos}}$ your own to use as reference.
