ACRYLICS OR OILS: Making your Mark with Palette Knife and Impasto Texture

PLEASE BRING

PAINTS:

PAINTS (oil or acrylic)

(Brands include: Windsor Newton (Winton), Grumbacher, Golden, Liquitex, etc.)

You want heavy based paints, as you won't be able to achieve what you want with craft/liquid paints.

9 BASIC COLORS:

Titanium White

Cadmium Yellow Light

Cadmium Red Middle

Alizarin Crimson

Ultramarine Blue (or Cobalt)

Phthalo Cerulean Blue

Sap Green

Yellow Ochre

Burnt Sienna

NOTE: You may have other colors as well; bring what you have.

BRUSHES and KNIVES

3/4 inch <u>flat</u> or filbert: synthetic bristle or combination natural and synthetic for oil/acrylic painting. #8 round (or size of your choice)

2 trowel-handled palette knives (pick 2 different blade shapes and sizes - 1 small; 1 large)

NOTE: Please bring a palette for laying out and mixing colors (such as a piece of board or foam board approx. size: 10"x12"), <u>rags or paper towels</u> for clean up, and a <u>lidded jar</u> to hold mineral spirits or water for clean up.

SUPPORTS

The following are appropriate supports for oils or acrylics: Fredrix - or other-- canvas panels that come in a variety of sizes, stretched canvas, or Masonite sanded and primed with gesso. Heavy weight paper and mat board painted with gesso are also suitable for acrylics and oils.
